UOSA Appoints Brian Steglitz as Executive Director

CENTREVILLE, March 15, 2024 -- The Board of Directors for the Upper Occoquan Service Authority (UOSA) has appointed **Brian Steglitz** as the next Executive Director of the Authority, effective May 13, 2024. Steglitz will succeed Bob Angelotti, who will retire in May after over thirty-eight years of service to UOSA.

An experienced leader in the utility sector, Steglitz is currently the Public Services Area Administrator for the City of Ann Arbor, Michigan, and a lecturer at the University of Michigan, Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering. After a nationwide search, the Board unanimously determined that Steglitz was the best candidate for the job.

“Brian brings the technical, leadership qualities and core values necessary to lead UOSA into the future,” said Board Chair Shahram Mohsenin. “He has a deep commitment to the industry and has written and spoken extensively on various industry topics, including PFAS. We are excited to welcome him as UOSA’s next Executive Director.”

Steglitz received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics and Political Science from Yale University and his Master of Civil and Environmental Engineering from Stanford University. He began his career at CH2M Hill, Inc. (now Jacobs) in Reston, Virginia.
